## PUNTER AND BANK

This game is one of the most played in our casino. The objective is to achieve 9 (nine) or to be near it. To play it the only thing to do is to chose between two types of bets, called 'PUNTER" (you bet against the person who takes out the cards) and BANK" (in favor of who takes out the cards).
The game starts when three or more persons sit at a table, but people standing around it can also play, the places to make the bets are duly marked, in case people have doubts, they can ask the payer to put the counter where they wish.
Once organized the game the payer will ask for four cards, the first one and the third one for the Punter, the second one and the forth one for the Bank if any of both or both get 8 (eight) or 9 (nine) the pass defines, if not a fifth card will be asked or a sixth and so on, it will win the One with points nearer to 9 (nine), if both have the same points there will be no winner and a new round starts.
The cards add points according to the number printed in them, except the 10 and the pictures considered without numerical value.
If the sum of both cards go up 9 (nine) the unit is taken as point, Ej.: 9 y $6=15$ the point achieved is 5 (five). If two pictures are received or one picture and one 10 (ten) the sum will be 0 (zero) and its called Baccarat.
The Bank will be given by auction and the person who acquires it will keep it up fill the punter wins, when this happens the sabot will pass to the person seated at its right.
The punter bets will be paid in equal quantities to the betted amount, the Bank ones get a 10\% discount.
