

CRAPS

It is a game of chance which gives a prize to/pays the different resulting combinations adding the points from the upper faces from two dice thrown with the hands on a table cloth, taking as a basic element the well-known Bank Craps.

The terms used in this game are:

Shooter: The player who rolls the dice.

Roll: the rolling of dice by the shooter

Come-out roll: The first time dice are rolled and a point is established.

Point: It is first roll worth which is equal to 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10.

The possible outcomes are called "chances" and are the following:

a) *A PASS LINE BET.* It pays 1 to 1. A pass line bet is won if the come-out roll is 7 or 11. If the come-out roll is 2, 3 or 12, the bet loses. If a 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10 is rolled, it establishes a point. If, with a point established, a seven is rolled before the point is re-rolled, the bet loses.

b) *DON'T PASS LINE BET.* It pays 1 to 1. It loses if the come-out roll is 7 or 11 and wins if the come-out roll is 2 or 3. A 12 will draw. If a point is established and that point is rolled again, the don't pass bet loses. If a 7 is rolled instead of the point being re-rolled, the don't pass bet wins.

c) *PASS ODDS.* It pays 1 to 1. It wins if the come-out roll is a 2 or 3, and loses if it is a 7 or 11. A 12 will draw. If a 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 or 10 are rolled, it establishes a point. If, with a point established, a seven is rolled before the point is re-rolled, the bet wins.

d) *DON'T PASS ODDS.* It pays 1 to 1. It wins if the come-out roll is a 7 or 11 and loses if it is a 2, 3 or 12. If a player is playing don't pass instead of pass, they may also lay odds betting behind the don't pass line. The bet loses if a 7 comes instead of the point coming.

e) *FIELD.* It pays 1 to 1. It is a single roll bet. It wins if a 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11 and 12 is rolled. If a 2 or 12 are rolled, it pays 2 to 1. It loses if a 5, 6, 7 or 8 are rolled.

f) *6 BIG 8.* It pays 1 to 1. A player can choose either the 6 or 8 being rolled. The bet loses if the shooter throws a seven. Bets may be placed directly by the players.

g) *ANY CRAP.* It pays 7 to 1. It is a single roll bet. It wins if the shooter rolls 2, 3 or 12; the bet loses if the other numbers are rolled.

h) *SEVEN.* It pays 4 to 1. It is a single roll bet. It wins if the shooter rolls a 7; it loses if the other numbers are rolled.

i) *ON THE HOP BETS.* Hop bets are located at the centre of the craps layout. If two 4 or two 5 are rolled on the hop, the bet pays 7 to 1. The bet loses when the opposite face of same number is rolled or with a 7. If two 3 or two 4 are rolled on the hop, the bet pays 9 to 1. Bets to 6 lose with an easy 6 (5-1, 4-2) or a 7. Bets to 8 lose with an easy 8 (5-3, 6-2) or a 7.

If a shooter rolls a 3 or 11, it pays 15 to 1. It is a single roll bet and loses when the other numbers are rolled. If a shooter rolls a 1 or 12, it pays 30 to 1. It is a single roll bet and loses when the other numbers are rolled.
